## ITINERARY

### DEPARTURE, THURSDAY



- Depart from the USA for your Jewish Heritage Israel Tour

### DAY 1, FRIDAY



- Upon arrival at **Ben Gurion Airport**, proceed to the arrival hall.
- Transfer to your hotel in Tel Aviv.

- Explore the city, enjoy a café, meet up with friends!

## DAY 3, SUNDAY



- Ride along the coast north to the beautiful **Caesarea**, once the Roman capital of the region; View the excavations of the Crusaders' city, the aqueduct, and the Amphitheatre that has been restored as a concert venue comparable in performers and musicians to Madison Square Garden or Carnegie Hall in NYC.
- Proceed to **Haifa** for panoramic view of the Baha'i Gardens and Haifa Bay.
- Enjoy a drive to **Acre** (Akko), the Old City recognized by UNESCO as a world heritage site; walk through the old port and local market.

## DAY 4, MONDAY



- Enjoy an adventurous **Jeep tour** at the foot of the **Golan Heights**.
- Proceed to a magnificent observation point over the city of Kuneitra and the Syrian territory.
- Walk the spectacular narrow alleyways and a picturesque Artists' quarter in **Safed** (Tzfat), one of the four holy cities in Israel. Visit the Caro and Ari synagogues.

## DAY 5, TUESDAY



- Drive to **Tiberias** to visit **Rambam's grave**; Continue through the Jordan valley to **Beit Shean**, known as "Scythopolis", and see the fascinating excavated remains from the Roman and Byzantine periods.
- Stop at **Beit Alpha** to admire the beautiful mosaic floor of a synagogue discovered in 1929.
- From there, journey to **Qasr al Yahud**, the traditional site where the Israelites crossed the Jordan River into the Promised Land. Continue via the Jordan Valley to Jerusalem; Stop at **Mount Scopus** for a blessing as you enter the city.

## DAY 6, WEDNESDAY



- Visit the Tomb of King David on **Mt. Zion**.
- Walkthrough the Jewish Quarter of the Old City of Jerusalem. See the **Cardo** - the heart of the ancient Roman City, visit the four **Sephardic Synagogues** restored after the 1967 war, tour the **Western Wall Tunnels**, and visit the archaeological park at **Davidson Center**;

## DAY 7, THURSDAY



- Start the day with a visit **The Israel Museum, Jerusalem**, the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea scrolls are housed, and the Holy Land Model, a miniature replica of Jerusalem as it was during the second temple period.
- Proceed to **Mount Herzl**, named after the founder of modern Zionism, to pay your respect to some of the nation's more influential figures. Continue to **Yad Vashem** - the museum that tells the stories of the Holocaust commemorates the lives of those who perished and survived its atrocities and ends with a breathtaking view of Jerusalem.

## DAY 8, FRIDAY



- Drive through the **Judean desert** to the **Dead Sea**-the lowest point on earth. Then, visit **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found.
- Ascend **Masada** by cable car and tour the mountain fortress built by King Herod, where the Zealots made their last stand against the Romans. Visit the remains of the walls, palaces, synagogue, and bathhouse. Descend by cable car.
- Next, stop for a “**Lunch and Swim**” at the spa facilities in one of the leading hotels in the area and enjoy a float in the mineral-rich Dead Sea.

## DAY 10, SUNDAY



- Travel south through the **Negev desert** to the **Vidor Center for Desert Agriculture**, where cutting-edge research and innovation focus on sustainable farming in arid conditions. Discover how technology and tradition combine to grow food in one of the world's harshest climates.
- Stop at **Timna**, a large geological and archaeological park. Marvel at the multicolored rock formations and copper mines and view the outstanding Solomon's pillars.
- Continue to **Eilat**, the southernmost resort city on the shores of the **Red Sea**.

## DAY 11, MONDAY - FREE DAY IN EILAT OR DAY TOUR TO PETRA (WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE)



- Straight to **Petra**, the astonishing rose-red city was built by the Nabateans (An early Arab tribe). Petra was renowned for its massive architecture, pools, dams, and water channels. The visit begins with the possibility of a short **horseback ride**. Petra is famous for its huge monuments such as the treasury, royal tombs, the court, roman theatre, roman street, Qasser el- Bint (Palace of Pharaoh's daughter), and many other smaller monuments which fascinate the visitors. The city is considered to be the second wonder of the world. \*Visa is required in advance
- After the visit, it's time for lunch in a nice restaurant.
- On the way, enjoy a short visit to **Aqaba** with the possibility to stop and take a walk around.
- Return to Eilat

## DAY 12, TUESDAY



- Start your day at **Eilat's Underwater Observatory**, a captivating window into the vibrant coral reefs and diverse marine life of the Red Sea. Experience an immersive underwater world without getting wet.
- Head North; stop to gaze into the **Ramon crater**, a geological wonder.
- Proceed to Tel Aviv.
