DAY 1, WEDNESDAY



- Upon arrival at **Ben Gurion Airport**, proceed to the arrival hall.
- Transfer to your hotel in Tel Aviv.

DAY 2, THURSDAY



- Start in **Old Jaffa**, one of the oldest port cities in the world. Visit the ancient ruins and walk along the Artists' Quarter to both purchase their crafts and see them work.
- Then travel from an old neighborhood to the first Hebrew-speaking neighborhood built in 1887, **Neve Tzedek**. Continue to **Nahalat Benyamin**, where you can enjoy live street music, arts, crafts, and handmade jewelry. These colorful streets are especially known for their unique shops, café life, and youthful ambiance.
- Explore your roots at the **ANU Museum of the Jewish People**. ANU connects Jewish people to their roots and strengthens their personal and collective Jewish identity. It tells the fascinating narrative of the Jewish people and the essence of Jewish culture, faith, purpose, and deed while presenting the contribution of world Jewry to humanity.

Overnight Tel-Aviv.

DAY 3, FRIDAY



- Begin the day with a visit to **Beit Guvrin** national park, declared by UNESCO as a world heritage site, and explore archaeological remains and unique caves.
- Continue to the **Gaza Envelope**, where the events of October 7, 2023 left a deep and lasting impact. Visit a lookout over the Gaza border to understand the proximity and vulnerability of the communities living here. Then stop at a roadside shelter along Route 232, where Aner Shapira displayed remarkable heroism while saving others. Visit the **Nova Festival site** near Re'im, where a peaceful gathering was transformed into a scene of unimaginable tragedy. Pay respects and hear the story of the young lives lost and the resilience shown in its aftermath.
- In **Sderot**, visit the site of the city's former police station, one of the first places targeted during the assault and a symbol of the fierce battles that took place.

DAY 4, SATURDAY

- Explore the city, enjoy a café, meet up with friends!

DAY 5, SUNDAY



- Ride along the coast north to the beautiful **Caesarea**, once the Roman capital of the region; View the excavations of the Crusaders' city, the aqueduct, and the Amphitheatre that has been restored as a concert venue comparable in performers and musicians to Madison Square Garden or Carnegie Hall in NYC.
- Proceed to **Haifa** for a panoramic view of the Baha'i Gardens and Haifa Bay. Enjoy a drive to **Acre** (Akko), the Old City recognized by UNESCO as a world heritage site; walk through the old port and local market.

Overnight at a Kibbutz guesthouse.

DAY 6, MONDAY



- Enjoy an adventurous **Jeep tour** at the foot of the **Golan Heights**.
- Proceed to a magnificent observation point over the city of Kuneitra and the Syrian territory.
- Walk the spectacular narrow alleyways and a picturesque Artists' quarter in **Safed** (Tzfat), one of the four holy cities in Israel.

Overnight at a Kibbutz guesthouse.

DAY 7, TUESDAY



- Drive to **Tiberias** to visit **Rambam's grave**; Continue through the Jordan valley to **Beit Shean**, known as "Scythopolis", and see the fascinating excavated remains from the Roman and Byzantine periods.
- From there, journey to **Qasr al Yahud**, the traditional site where the Israelites crossed the Jordan River into the Promised Land.
- Continue via the Jordan Valley to Jerusalem; Stop at **Mount Scopus** for a blessing as you enter the city.

Overnight Jerusalem.

DAY 8, WEDNESDAY



- Visit the Tomb of King David on **Mt. Zion**.
- Walkthrough the Jewish Quarter of the Old City of Jerusalem. See the **Cardo** - the heart of the ancient Roman City, visit the four **Sephardic Synagogues** restored after the 1967 war, tour the **Western Wall Tunnels**, and visit the archaeological park at **Davidson Center**;


DAY 9, THURSDAY



- Start with a visit **The Israel Museum, Jerusalem**, the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea scrolls are housed, and the Holy Land Model, a miniature replica of Jerusalem as it was during the second temple period.
- Proceed to **Mount Herzl**, named after the founder of modern Zionism, to pay your respect to some of the nation's more influential figures. Continue to **Yad Vashem** - the museum that tells the stories of the Holocaust commemorates the lives of those who perished and survived its atrocities and ends with a breathtaking view of Jerusalem.

Overnight Jerusalem.

DAY 10, FRIDAY



- Drive through the **Judean desert** to the **Dead Sea**-the lowest point on earth. Then, visit **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found.
- Ascend **Masada** by cable car and tour the mountain fortress built by King Herod, where the Zealots made their last stand against the Romans. Visit the remains of the walls, palaces, synagogue, and bathhouse. Descend by cable car.
- Next, stop for a “**Lunch and Swim**” at the spa facilities in one of the leading hotels in the area and enjoy a float in the mineral-rich Dead Sea.

DAY 11, SATURDAY

DAY 12, SUNDAY



- Journey deep into the heart of the Negev Desert to the **Vidor Center for Desert Agriculture**, where cutting-edge research and innovation focus on sustainable farming in arid conditions. Discover how technology and tradition combine to grow food in one of the world's harshest climates. Stop at **Timna**, a large geological and archaeological park. Marvel at the multicolored rock formations and copper mines and view the outstanding Solomon's pillars.
- Continue to **Eilat**, the southernmost resort city on the shores of the **Red Sea**.

DAY 13, MONDAY FREE DAY IN EILAT OR DAY TOUR TO PETRA (WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE)



- Straight to **Petra**, the astonishing rose-red city was built by the Nabateans (An early Arab tribe). Petra was renowned for its massive architecture, pools, dams, and water channels. The visit begins with the possibility of a short **horseback ride**. Petra is famous for its huge monuments such as the treasury, royal tombs, the court, roman theatre, roman street, Qasser el- Bint (Palace of Pharaoh's daughter), and many other smaller monuments which fascinate the visitors. The city is considered to be the second wonder of the world. *visa required in advance
- After the visit, it's time for lunch in a nice restaurant.
- On the way, enjoy a short visit to **Aqaba** with the possibility to stop and take a walk around.
- Return to Eilat

Overnight, Eilat

DAY 14, TUESDAY



- Start your day at **Eilat's Underwater Observatory**, a captivating window into the vibrant coral reefs and diverse marine life of the Red Sea. Experience an immersive underwater world without getting wet. Depart **Eilat** via **Mitzpe Ramon**; stop to gaze into the **Ramon crater**, the world's largest erosion crater and one of Israel's most spectacular geological formations. Marvel at the crater's unique landscape and visit the visitor center for insights into its geology and natural history.
- Continue to Tel Aviv.

DAY 15, WEDNESDAY



Transfer to Ben-Gurion airport for departure.
